In 1995, the MCC introduced the Harmony Ribbon Campaign to raise awareness of cultural diversity and to promote a harmonious society. The HARMONY RIBBON is worn as a visible symbol of the respect and understanding that we have for one another and as a sign of our desire to live in a community that is free from racism and discrimination.

The colors of the ribbon, GREEN for the land and BLUE for the sky and ocean, represent our hope and unity as citizens of Earth. RED roses represent love, respect, and courage. Together they symbolize the beauty and harmony of our diverse community.
